General Guidelines

1. Applicant must be a Nolensville resident and a high school senior.
2. Applicant must be in good standing with current high school. Good standing entails being currently active with good attendance and no disciplinary action from school.
3. The following information must be turned in by the deadline to be eligible for the scholarship:
 - Buttercup Festival Scholarship Application
 - Official High School Transcript
 - ACT/SAT Scores
 - Two Letters of Reference from a mentor and/or teacher
 - Applicants must submit a 1,000 word essay responding to one of the following:
 - a. How has living in Nolensville affected the way you see the world?
 - b. If you had the authority to change your community in a positive way, what specific changes would you make?
 - c. Who in your life has been your biggest influence and why?
4. Applications are reviewed in full. We consider your essay, transcripts, recommendations, and involvement.
5. Incomplete applications will not be considered for scholarships.
6. Scholarship awards will be made payable to the college or university when The Buttercup Festival Committee receives student's ID number, appropriate university address, contact person, and copy of class schedule.
7. All scholarship funds will be applied to student's first semester.
